


#### Not to be confused with web accommodations:

Federal Government Contractors – Section 503 & VEVRAA: If you utilize an online application system, you must "provide necessary reasonable accommodation to ensure that an otherwise qualified individual with a disability who is not able to fully utilize that system is nonetheless provided with equal opportunity to apply and be considered for all jobs."



















#### Roots in the Law


## ADA Title III Website Accessibility Lawsuits in Federal Court 2017-2021

#### Total Number of ADA Title III Federal Lawsuits Filed Each Year






# Accessibility is a right
