History of Registered Apprenticeships

- Colonial Period formal training lead to an occupation.
- After Industrial Revolution increase in technology faster production – increase in educational system – vocational schools.
- Increase in trade unions during 20th century
- Community Colleges really started becoming sponsors since 2016 – meet the demand of middle skill level jobs.



- 38% more active apprentices than the previous 10-year average (633,000 vs. 459,000)
- 319,000+ participants completed an apprenticeship in the last five years








ECCA Registered Apprenticeship Programs by DOL ETA Region


Region 4 ECCA College Partner Progress Projected vs Actual


