






- ✓ 25% of LGBTQ youth are thrown out of their homes when they come out .
- ✓ LGBTQ youth remain 3-4 times more likely to attempt suicide.
- √ 40% of homeless youth self-identify as LGBTQ
- ✓ LGB youth are at higher risk of alcohol, substance abuse, depression, suicidality than other youth
- ✓ Highest rate of new HIV infections occur in youth 13-24; African-American youth aged 13-24 accounted for 65% of new HIV infections.

How students experience their campus environment influences both learning and developmental outcomes.1





One-third of Trans-spectrum (38%) respondents seriously considered leaving their institution due to the challenging climate




LGB Youth Drug Use & Abuse


Examined relationship between sexual orientation and adolescent substance use.

- LGB youth were 190% more likely than heterosexual youth to use substances
- Bisexual youth were 340% more likely than heterosexual youth to use substances.
- Lesbian youth were 400% more likely than heterosexual youth to use substances.



- Strong affinity to brands at early age who they view as doing the right thing
- Expectation of diversity in workplace policies, programs & practices.
- Sense of immediacy "want it now" culture
- Need for affirmation and safe space
- Fear & stigma around Corporate America (particularly for trans, genderqueer, nonbinary, bi, pansexual identities)





- Build "authentic" relationships early-on
- Promote LGBTQ-inclusion directly to the demographic of LGBTQ young people
- Target recruitment efforts at LGBTQ-friendly and inclusive campuses
- Go to places where LGBTQ young people go: be visible, be active, be present in unique, meaningful ways






- Seek involvement with LGBTQ youth orgs and events that are "for and by" LGBTQ young people
- Be aware of anti-LGBTQ associations or actions that may damage brand reputation
